3. INCREASE IN DEARNESS RELIEF TO CANTT. BOARD PENSIONERS

To consider UP Govt. G.O.No.23/2015/Sa-3-G1 21/x-2015 - 301/2000 TC dt.16-12-2015 has sanctioned additional dearness Relief @ 6% from 113% to 119% to UP Govt. Pensioners w.e.f. 01-07-2015. The increase of Dearness Relief is also applicable to Cantt. Fund Employees.

The Dte DE CC has sanctioned the increase of Dearness Relief to Cantt. Fund Pensioners @ 119% w.e.f. 01-07-2015 vide their letter No.49260/UP/DR/PENS/LCP dated 22-02-2016.

One post of Assistant Engineer has fallen vacant due to technical resignation dated 16-11-2015 by Shri Manish Kumar, Asstt. Engineer who was relieved from this office on 30-11-2015. The post of Asstt. Engineer is an essential post and is required to be filled up immediately.

5. RES: Considered and resolved to fill up the vacant post of Assistant Engineer through permissible Channel, and as per Govt. Guidelines issued for direct recruitment.

6. **UPGRADATION OF POST OF JUNIOR ENGINEER TO ASSISTANT ENGINEER**

Shri Om Prakash, Junior Engineer has completed more than 32 years satisfactory services and presently he is getting the pay scale of Assistant Engineer. He is going to retire in December 2017.

As per memorandum of settlement dated 13-05-1969, the post of Junior Engineers of Cantonment is equated with Junior Engineers of State P.W.D., hence individual is entitled to get all the benefits which the State P.W.D., Junior Engineer are getting. The Cantonment Board vide C.B.R. No. 7 dated 07-11-2015 has approved the grade pay of Rs.7600/- in pay scale of 15600-39100.

As per Service Rules – 2004, U.P. Govt. P.W.D., order No.8448/23-4-2003-86. A.E//2003 dated 03-01-2004, 50% post of Assistant Engineers are filled up by promotion of Junior Engineers who has completed 7 year services.

In view of his experience, it is proposed that the post of Shri Om Prakash, Junior Engineer, be upgraded to the post of Assistant Engineer, which would be again reverted back to the post of J.E. after his retirement.

Relevant file is placed on the table. Board to consider for further course of action.

6. RES: The Board considered and resolved that, considering the long satisfactory services of Shri Om Prakash JE, his post be upgraded to Assistant Engineer, because there is no promotional post of Assistant Engineer exist in the Board.

- The discretion to allot the Guest House rest with CEO only.

- Occupants/allottee should take care of his/her belongings and Cantonment Board Authorities will not be responsible for any theft etc. in the manner what so ever.
- Any damage to furniture, fixtures of fitting as available in the suit or any other part of the Guest House done by the allottee or his servant if any shall be charged separately and payable by the allottee.
- The allottee is required to use electricity as economically as possible. They will switch off lights, AC, Electric Heaters and any other appliances when they leave their rooms.

In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board Allahabad shall be final, binding and conclusive.

(c) Kitchen Facility:-

Food would be provided to the guests as per following rates, in Cantonment Guest House:-

8. RES: The Board discussed the matter in detail, and resolved to prepare the SOP of Guest House in details, and would be considered in next Board Meeting.

Meantime the booking of Guest House be done as per charges/conditions mentioned in agenda side.

9. **CIVIL MISC WRIT PETITION NO. 31792 OF 2014**

Reference C.B.R. No. 13 dated 30-04-2014

Work order dated 04-09-2012 was issued to M/s Karamat Brothers 1C/1, Idgah, Allahabad for repair and re-boring of existing hand pumps in Cantt. Area. As per work order dated 04.09.2012 work was required to be completed by 31-03-2013 but the contractor had failed to complete the work by 31-03-2013. Several extensions were granted but he contractor did not complete the work as per work order.

The Cantonment Board vide C.B.R. No. 13 (2) dated 10-03-2014 considered the representation of elected members with regard to incomplete work of repair and re-boring of work of hand pumps and constituted a committee consisting of 3 elected members to visit the works on ground and recommend to next Board.

The Cantonment Board vide C.B.R. under reference considered the case with report of aforementioned committee and resolved that M/s Karamat Brothers, 1C/1, Idgah, Allahabad be banned for three years, thereby no tender/works shall be given to them.

M/s Karamat Brothers filed a Writ Petition No. 31792 of 2014 in the Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad in which the Hon'ble High Court ordered as under :-

"The issue stands settled by various pronouncements of the Hon'ble Apex Court. Reference may be made to the decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Southern Painters vs. Fertilizers AND Chemicals Travancore Ltd. and another, MANU/SC/0294/1994** wherein it has been held that if any government contractor of the approved list is blacklisted, it is necessary that he must be given an opportunity to be heard. To the same effect is the decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Gorkha Security Services v. Govt of NCT of Delhi, Law (SC) -2014-8-2.**

In view of above settled law on the subject, the resolution no. 13 of the Cantonment Board, Allahabad dated 30-04-2014 blacklisting the petitioner for a period of 3 years and the consequential order dated 15.5.2014 is not liable to be sustained being in utter violation of principle of natural justice and is hereby quashed. It shall, however, be open to the respondent Board to pass fresh resolution in accordance with law after giving notice and opportunity to the petitioner to show cause.

Writ petition stands allowed to the extent directed above.

However, we do not make any order as to costs.

Order Date: - 22.2.2016"

9. RES: The Board discussed the Hon'ble High Court Order dated 22-02-2016 in Civil Misc. Writ Petition No.31792 of 2014, and resolved, that in compliance with Hon'ble High Court Order the petitioner be given the notice and opportunity to show cause, why action of blacklisting is not taken against his firm. The reply of petitioner be put up to the Board for reconsideration of the matter.

10. RE-BORING OF PUMP HOUSE NO. 2

Reference C.B.R. No.7 dated 20-01-2016.

Cantonment Board vide resolution under reference has approved the estimate amounting to Rs.17.08 lacs for re-boring of Tube well at Pump House No. 2 Sadar Bazar, New Cantt. Allahabad submitted by Project Manager, Construction and Design services U.P. Jal Nigam Allahabad. Site was not approved for re-boring of tube well.

Site Comprising Sy. No. 88/261, near Amba complex, Sadar Bazar has been selected for re-boring of tube well which is Class 'C' land.

As requested by this office, the Project Manager, C&DS, UP Jal Nigam has submitted the estimate for Pump House, DG Set room, required raising main work and pump set & column pipes etc. amounting to Rs. 13.76 LACS as without these related works the tube could not be made functional.

Board to consider for further course of action.

Relevant file is places on the table.

10. RES: The Board considered and approved the site of Sy.No.88/261 near Amba Complex, Sadar Bazar, for re-boring of Pump House No.2.

The Board also approved the estimates of Rs.13.76 lacs, given by Project Manager, C&DS, UP Jal Nigam for Pump House, DG Set room, required raising main work and Pump Set & column pipes.

The Board resolved to get the work done directly from UP Jal Nigam.

COPY OF C.B.RES. NO.11 DATED 28-03-2016

11. RENEWAL OF LEASE, MUTATION IN RESPECT OF SITE COMPRISING SY.NO.111/2 AND 111/3 HOUSE NO. 10 AND 11 KYDGANJ, FORT CANTT. ALLAHABAD

Ref CBR No 1(xxi) dated 17.02.2016

Site measuring 4000 Sqft. Comprising Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt. was leased out to one Sri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VI of CLAR, 1925 for residential purpose on annual rent of Rs. 21/- for a period of 30 years renewable at the option of the lessee upto 90 years w.e.f. 26-06-1935.

The term of lease had expired on 25-06-1965.

Similarly, the Site measuring 4000 Sqft. Comprising Sy. No. 111/3, Kydganj, Fort Cantt. was also leased out to Sri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VI of CLAR, 1925 for residential purpose on annual rent of Rs. 21/- for a period of 30 years renewable at the option of the lessee upto 90 years w.e.f. 22-06-1935.

The term of this lease had expired on 21-06-1965.

While initiating the proposal for renewal for further term of 30 years lessee had also requested for change of purpose as the site was being used for commercial purposes in violation of condition 1 (6) of the lease. The Cantonment Board vide C.B. Resolution No. 5 dated 25-06-1965 resolved that proposal for renewal of lease and change of purpose be submitted to GOC-in-Chief and accordingly necessary proposal was submitted to HQCC, Lucknow vide Cantt. Board letter No.Y38/2458 dated 11-08-1965.

The GOC-in-Chief, HQ, Central Command, Lucknow vide letter No.32847-LC3/11 dated 02-09-1968 returned the proposal for its re-submission for fresh lease and accordingly proposal was submitted for two fresh lease in respect of site comprising Sy. No. 111/2 and 111/3 for commercial purposes vide letter dated 21-11-1968.

The Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence, new Delhi vide letter No.7/3/L/L&C/69/7828/D (Lands) dated 23-08-1969 had conveyed the sanction of the President to the following measures –

- (i) Grant of lease of 4000 Sqft of land comprising sy. No. 111/2 for the purpose of a soap factory to Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VIII CLAR, 1937 with effect from 26-06-1965, on payment of an annual rental of Rs.120/- and an initial premium of Rs.1840/-
- (ii) Grant of lease of 4000 Sqft. of land comprising Sy. No. 111/3, for the purpose of Plastic factory to Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VIII CLAR, 1937 with effect from 22-06-1965, on payment of an annual rental of Rs. 120/- and a premium of Rs.1840/-.
- (iii) Payment of additional rent of Rs.42/- per annum by Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal for the unauthorised use of premises w.e.f. August 1964 to the dates of expiry of the leases in Schedule VI of CLAR,1925.

The sanction of the Govt. was communicated to Sri Kundan Lal Jaiswal vide letter dated 09-10-1969, 22-01-1970 and 08-06-1970 vide which he was required to deposit rent and premium as per Govt. sanction amounting to Rs.4937.22 but he had not deposited the rent, premium and made a representation dated 08-07-1970 that he has changed his mind and decided not to use the premises for commercial purposes and requested that lease in respect of site comprising Sy. No.111/2 be renewed for residential purposes and out of Sy. No.111/3 an area measuring 1500 sqft be granted for commercial purposes and rest of the area 2500 Sqft for dwelling purposes.

Accordingly a proposal as requested by the lessee was submitted vide Cantt. Board letter dated 29-10-1971.

After a long correspondence, since the change of purposes involved in the subject case was not discontinued after June 1965, the HQ, Central Command (ML&C) letter No. 32847-LC3/63 dated 29-06-1974 directed to ask the lessee to pay the site rent and premium immediately as per sanction of Govt. otherwise a self contained proposal for cancellation of Govt. sanction and resumption of sites may be initiated immediately. Accordingly a letter dated 17-07-1974 was issued to the lessee for deposit of Rs. 5897.28 as rent up to 1974 and premium as Govt. sanction and after a long correspondence he has deposited all the dues. The lease as sanctioned by the Govt. letter dated 23-08-1969 has not been executed.

Now the legal heirs of Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal, S/Shri Kunwar Narendra Narayan Singh and Kunwar Arvind Narayan Singh sons of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal vide letter dated 15.02.2016 requested for mutation of property in their favour, execution of lease as sanctioned by the Govt vide letter dated 23.08.1969 renewal of further term of lease as sanctioned by the Govt vide letter dated 23.08.1969 . Vide application they have submitted following documents :-

- (i) Family member certificate dated 10-03-2014 of Late Kundan Lal Jaiswal issued by Tahsildar according to which family members are
 - (a) Kunwar Narendra Narayan Singh
 - (b) Kunwar Arvind Narayan Singh sons of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal
 - (c) Smt. Sudha Rani Jaiswal daughter of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal
- (ii) Death certificate of Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal issued by Nagar Mahapalika, Allahabad which shows that the lessee has expired on 24-06-1974.

Smt. Sudha Rani Jaiswal sister of both the applications given an affidavit that she has no objection if the both the properties are mutated in favor of S/Shri Kunwar Narendra Narayan Singh and Kunwar Arvind Narayan Singh sons of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal.

Site is situated within notified civil area and is placed under the management of Cantonment Board; presently site does not involve any, encroachment, change of purpose and sub-division of site.

Public notices inviting claims and objections were published in local News papers "Amar Ujala" and "Hindustan Times" on 20.02.2016 but any objection and claims has not been received from anybody. Period of 30 days has been expired on 20.03.2016.

Relevant file is placed on the table.

Board to consider for further course of action.

- 11. RES:** The Board considered the matter and resolved that name of Kunwar Narendra Narain Singh and Kunwar Arvind Narain Singh S/o Late Kundan Lall Jaiswal be mutated in respect of site comprising Sy.No.111/2 (House No.11) and site comprising Sy.No.111/3 (House No.10), in place of Shri Kundan Lall Jaiswal. The Board further resolved to recommend that lease be renewed for final term of 30 years w.e.f. 26-06-1995 to 25-06-2025 in respect of site comprising Sy.No.111/2, and w.e.f. 22-06-1995 to 21-06-2025 in respect of site comprising Sy.No.111/3. Necessary proposal be submitted to competent authority for obtaining necessary sanction, for renewal of lease.
