There are only 8 registered contractors in this Cantonment Board. Out 8, one M/s Autar Singh Bhatia and Sons, contractor are not available at their last known address since long and therefore, all the letters addressed to him are returned back to this office. Another contractor M/s Karamat Brothers was banned by this office and their case is under consideration of the Board. Hence, presently only 6 contractors are available for participating in tender, however, since the starting of E-tendering most of them are not participating in tender proceeding and competitive tenders are not received. Most of the times either sufficient tenders are not received or no tender are received.

In view of the above it is proposed that registration of contractors be opened, as per Cantt. Board Bye-laws, and term and condition of MES for such registration.

Board to consider for further course of action.

7. RES: **The Board considered and resolved that enlistment/registration of approved contractors be opened, to increase healthy competition amongst civil contractors: The application should be invited from eligible contractors, as per Cantt. Board Bye-laws, and terms, condition of MES for such registration.**

**11. PROVIDING AND FIXING DECORATIVE POLES AND LED LIGHTS ON PONAPPA ROAD FROM AMBEDKAR PARK TO CHIEF JUSTICE RESIDENC**

To consider estimate amounting to Rs 63 lacs for providing and fixing decorative 7.5 m long pole with 90 watt LED lighting fixtures.

The estimate along with relevant file is placed on the table.

**11. RES: The Board considered and approved the estimates of Rs.63 lacs for Supply and fixing of poles and LED lights on Ponappa Road.**

**The Board further resolved that estimates from Ambedkar Park to CDA Pension may also be prepared for the same work.**

**12. CIVIL MISC WRIT PETITION NO. 31792 OF 2014**

Reference C.B.R. No. 09 dated 28-03-2016

Work order dated 04-09-2012 was issued to M/s Karamat Brothers 1C/1, Idgah, Allahabad for repair and re-boring of existing hand pumps in Cantt. Area. As per work order dated 04.09.2012 work was required to be completed by 31-03-2013 but the contractor had failed to complete the work by 31-03-2013. Several extensions were granted but he contractor did not complete the work as per work order.

The Cantonment Board vide C.B.R. No. 13 (2) dated 10-03-2014 considered the representation of elected members with regard to incomplete work of repair and re-boring of work of hand pumps and constituted a committee consisting of 3 elected members to visit the works on ground and recommend to next Board.

The Cantonment Board vide C.B.R. under reference considered the case with report of aforementioned committee and resolved that M/s Karamat Brothers, 1C/1, Idgah, Allahabad be banned for three years, thereby no tender/works shall be given to them.

M/s Karamat Brothers file a Writ Petition No. 31792 of 2014 in the Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad in which the Hon'ble High Court ordered as under :-

“The issue stands settled by various pronouncements of the Hon'ble Apex Court. Reference may be made to the decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Southern Painters vs. Fertilizers AND Chemicals Travancore Ltd. and another, MANU/SC/0294/1994** wherein it has been held that if any government contractor of the approved list is blacklisted, it is necessary that he must be given an opportunity to be heard. To the same effect is the decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Gorkha Security Services v. Govt of NCT of Delhi, Law (SC) -2014-8-2.**

In view of above settled law on the subject, the resolution no. 13 of the Cantonment Board, Allahabad dated 30-04-2014 blacklisting the petitioner for a period of 3 years and the consequential order dated 15.5.2014 is not liable to be sustained being in utter violation of principle of natural justice and is hereby quashed. It shall, however, be open to the respondent Board to pass fresh resolution in accordance with law after giving notice and opportunity to the petitioner to show cause.

Writ petition stands allowed to the extent directed above.

However, we do not make any order as to costs.

**Order Date: - 22.2.2016”**

Cantonment Board vide CBR under reference discussed the Hon'ble High Court order dated 22.02.2016 passed in Civil Misc. Writ Petition No 31792 of 2014, and resolved, that in compliance with Hon'ble High Court order the petitioner be given the notice and opportunity to show cause, why action of blacklisting is not taken against his firm. Accordingly show cause notice was issued to the petitioner vide letter No TC/HP/2012-13/311 dated 30.04.2016. Petitioner, M/s Karamat Brothers has given reply to show cause notice vide their letter No KB/CB/HP/2016 dated 16.05.2016.

Relevant file is placed on the table along with reply to show cause notice. Board to consider for further course of action.

**12. RES: Board has considered and gone through the reply of show cause notice dated 16.05.2016 given by M/s Karamat Brothers, 1C/1, Idgah, Allahabad. The Board after going through the entire record relating to the contract, work order and agreement found that the reply given by M/s Karamat Brothers is not satisfactory and unexplained. M/s Karamat Brothers has not completed the work as per details given in work order dated 04.09.2012. Despite given extension of time to complete the work the contractor has not completed the work as per details given in work order. Due to incomplete work general public have faced lot of hardship, even the members of the Board have faced lot of public complaints about their hardship.
