2. INCREASE IN DEARNESS ALLOWANCE TO CANTT. BOARD EMPLOYEES

To consider UP Govt. G.O. No.4/2016/Ve-Aa-1-430/Das-2016-42(M)/2008 dated 13-06-2016 has sanctioned additional Dearness Allowance from 119% to 125% to UP Govt. Employees of their Basic Pay and Grade Pay w.e.f. 01-01-2016. The increase of Dearness Allowance is also applicable to Cantt. Fund Employees.

The Dte DE CC has sanctioned the increase of Dearness Allowance to Cantt. Fund Employees @ 125% w.e.f. 01-01-2016 vide their letter No.9334/UP/DA/LCP dated 05-07-2016.

2. RES: Noted and approved the increase of Dearness Allowance from 119% to 125% to Cantt. Fund Employees w.e.f. 01-01-2016. Strictly as per the terms and condition contained in UP Govt. G.O. No.4/2016/Ve-Aa-1-430/Das-2016-42(M)/2008 dated 13-06-2016 and Dte DE CC letter No.9334/UP/DA/LCP dated 05-07-2016.

3. PLANTATION PROGRAMME IN CANTONMENT

To consider and approve the Plantation programme of Cantonment as follows for the year 2016-2017. The matter was taken up with District Forest Officer to provide the Saplings for plantation programme. District Forest Officer vide his letter dated 19-07-2016, has forwarded the willingness and Govt. approved rates for supply of saplings. It is recommend that approximate 5000 trees of Ashoka, Gulmohar, Silver oak and Shisham be purchased for plantation.
